WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Transfers reporting requirements related to English language learner programs from school districts to Department of Education. Adjusts timelines for making reports. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- History of English Language Learner (ELL) programs, including major revisions of existing programs via HB 3499 (2015)
- Value of properly audited data
- Desire of school districts to avoid duplicative reports

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

Requires each school district to make reported information available annually, September 1 of each year, at both the school district's main office and on the school district website. FISCAL: Has minimal fiscal impact REVENUE: No revenue impact

BACKGROUND:

Currently, under the distribution formula for the State School Fund, students designated as belonging to "English language learning" category receive an additional 0.5 weight, for a total weighted Average Daily Membership (ADMw) of 1.5. Within the broad category of ELL programs, there is no specific restriction, and limited reporting, around how this money may be spent. House Bill 3499 (2015) represented a broad overhaul of ELL programs policy. It did a number of things, including creating work groups to address challenges to coding and budget transparency ELL program challenges and best practices.

Senate Bill 1564 would transfer reporting requirements established by House Bill 3499 from school districts to the Oregon Department of Education, and would also adjust timelines for making reports to accommodate departmental data and reporting best practices.
