Alaska	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Unanimous jury verdict ✓ Grand jury testimony is recorded verbatim ✓ Copy of recorded grand jury testimony is given to defense counsel ✓ Indictment must be based on legally admissible evidence (limited hearsay exceptions; no blanket exception for hearsay)

Hawaii	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Unanimous jury verdict ✓ Grand jury testimony is video recorded verbatim ✓ Copy of video-recorded grand jury testimony is available to defense counsel ✓ Indictment must be based on legally admissible evidence (limited hearsay allowed only if not deliberately presented in place of better evidence)

Idaho	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Unanimous jury verdict ✓ Grand jury testimony is recorded verbatim ✓ Copy of recorded grand jury testimony is given to defense counsel ✓ Indictment must be based on legally admissible evidence (no blanket exception for hearsay)

Nevada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Unanimous jury verdict ✓ Grand jury testimony is recorded verbatim ✓ Copy of recorded grand jury testimony is available to defense counsel ✓ Indictment must be based on legally admissible evidence (no blanket exception for hearsay)

Washington	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Unanimous jury verdict ✓ Subject to judicial oversight and approval, each party may take sworn recorded deposition statement of opposite party's witnesses prior to trial

Oregon is different: non-unanimous jury verdicts, no recorded grand jury

Oregon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Non-unanimous jury verdict, allowing 10 -2 verdict to convict ✓ Fails to record grand jury testimony, instead relying on handwritten notes taken by grand juror ✓ Forbids defense or the courts access to grand jury notes; notes remain in sole custody of the district attorney
