The City of Wilsonville supports SB 1582 as introduced as a straight-forward, common-sense approach to helping address the affordable housing crisis in Oregon. Active State engagement in creating new affordable housing opportunities can be part of a larger, multi-pronged strategy to deal with the current shortage of such residential living space.
