**Measure Description:**

Directs Department of State Police to adopt rules concerning prioritization of testing untested sexual assault forensic evidence kits.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Cities, Counties, Department of Justice, Judicial Department, Legislative Administration Committee (LAC), Legislative Assembly, Oregon State Police (OSP), Public Defense Services Commission

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**
