WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires the Departments of Revenue and Human Services to implement a pilot program for the monthly distribution of dependent care tax credits. Requires the Department of Revenue to provide the Department of Human Services a list of tax credit claimants that DHS will compare to Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program participants. Individuals who are both SNAP participants and dependent care tax credit claimants will be notified by DHS that they are eligible to participate in the pilot program. The bill outlines the details of the pilot program. Applies to tax years 2016 through 2021.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

-1: prohibits DHS from considering the installment payments as income for purposes of determining eligibility for TANF, section 1931 medical assistance, and SNAP.

BACKGROUND:
