

As I understand it, House Bill 4147 (HB 4147) will be heard in the House Judiciary Committee on Feb 4, 2016. This note is intended to be comments regarding HB 4147:

As I understand it, SB 941 contains a provision that allows a firearm transfer to go forward if the background check has not been completed in three days. HB 4147 seeks to remove that safeguard.

If this bill passes the safeguard will be removed, and a transaction can be delayed indefinitely. In addition, the people desiring to complete the transaction have no recourse.

To me, this legislation clearly demonstrates the intent of the groups seeking to pass so called reasonable gun control laws. This law will do nothing to improve public safety. It is simply another means to make the private ownership of firearms more difficult.

Please do not support HB 4147.
