

Statuary Hall Compromise – House Bill 4129

- HB 4129 will facilitate the building of 3 statues.
 - Chief Joseph
 - Abigail Scott Duniway
 - Mark Odom Hatfield
- Statues not on display in Statuary Hall will be displayed in a prominent location at the State Capitol.
- Directs the Legislative Administrator to work with Idaho to resolve where the Chief Joseph statue will reside . One option is to send Chief Joseph to D.C. to be displayed on behalf of Idaho first, then Oregon.
 - In the event that this cannot be worked out with Idaho Chief Joseph will be prominently displayed with the other statues at the State Capitol until the time period in which he can be sent to D.C, to represent Oregon.
- John McLoughlin and Jason Lee, who are currently displayed in Washington D.C., will be displayed at the Oregon State Capitol.
- Creates fund for the housing of donations
 - Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate from the General Fund.
 - Donations can be earmarked for a specific statue to complete them individually, and not as a group.
 - Statues are sent to D.C. as they are completed.
