**Subject:** HB 4075, relating to student safety

---

House Bill 4075A establishes a statewide tip line for reports of threats to student safety. The line must receive telephone calls, text messages, or electronic messages through the internet, and it must be connected to other hotlines. Tips are to be confidential, and information on threats must be relayed to local service providers and school officials, in addition to the Oregon State Police (OSP) and local law enforcement.

The measure appropriates \$1 million to the Oregon State Police for the implementation of the line. The OSP must develop rules on processing the calls, including how to protect the identity of the call while enabling return contact, logging reports, verifying authenticity of reports, and relaying that information to local law enforcement and school district officials. The agency's fiscal impact estimate includes costs for three positions to administer the tip line, and contract services payments to a third-party vendor to operate the tip line. The measure repeals a tip line housed within the Department of Justice.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, a preliminary Joint Committee on Ways and Means staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement, and measure history are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

LFO recommends the measure be moved to the full Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
