Testimony in Support of SB 1533A February 22, 2016, Hearing Room A, 8:30 pm Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue

Chair Hass, Vice Chair Boquist and Senators Baertschiger, Edwards and Riley:

The Oregon Advocacy Commissions share a long standing interest with the communities of color and women across Oregon in the foundation of all personal and family success: affordable housing. Community leaders need tools to help them work with their local housing industry to assure that all their citizens can afford to live in the neighborhoods of their hometowns.

This bill seeks to provide the needed tools to city officials across Oregon for inclusionary zoning including multifamily units, allowing such units to be for sale or rental and within reach of individuals and families of modest means. It also requires local government to offer incentives for development of inclusionary zoning units, which we believe fosters the kind of flexibility and collaborative work with developers needed to create affordable units in a broad spectrum of neighborhoods.

While there is more to be done in Oregon to improve access to affordable housing, we believe that SB 1533A is a step in the right direction and encourage your positive consideration.
