Work Session Recommendations

HB 4086 - Relating to unemployment benefits of individuals who are unemployed due to lockouts. The bill provides an additional twenty-six weeks of UI benefits for lockout workers in an amount equal to the individuals most recent unemployment claim.

The measure, amendment, Revenue Impact Statement and staff measure summary are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

The measure previously had a public hearing and work session in the House Committee on Business and Labor and was referred to Ways and Means by prior reference.

The measure originally had an estimated fiscal impact of \$53,000 Other Funds to the Employment Department in the 2015-17 biennium; however after further review of the agency budget the Legislative Fiscal Office does not recommend additional Other Funds expenditure limitation and the provisions of the bill can be implemented using existing budgetary resources.

Measure as Modified

The measure is recommended to be moved to the full Committee on Joint Ways and Means.

Motion: Move HB 4086 to the full committee with a “do pass” recommendation.
