Oregon businesses need access to basic banking services

The real and perceived threat of federal prosecution means that most banks and credit unions are unwilling to offer accounts to cannabis —related businesses. This means that as Oregon moves forward with legal, licensed and regulated adult use and medical cannabis markets, almost all business is conducted in cash.

Ultimately, federal action is needed to assure access to banking. <u>But</u>

<u>Oregon law that puts banks and credit unions at risk of criminal</u>

liability for offering banking services to lawful cannabis businesses.

Banking access is a public safety issue

All-cash businesses pose a public safety threat to the community as well as business owners, their employees and their property.

Allowing licensed and compliant cannabis businesses access to banks and credit unions will help protect our communities from criminal activity and violence.

Banking access supports Oregon regulators

Access to basic banking services ensures more accurate bookkeeping and accounting, resulting in less administrative burden for regulatory agencies and more revenue for state and local governments.

Most legal cannabis businesses in Oregon must conduct all business in cash, putting public safety at risk

HB 4094A

- Instructs the Oregon
 Department of
 Consumer and Business
 Services to look into
 other temporary
 solutions. DCBS would
 report their findings and
 make a recommendation
 to the Legislature by
 January 1, 2017.
