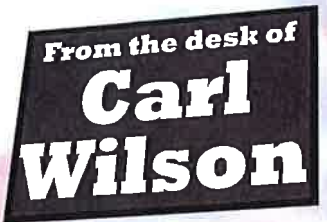

HB 4060 A~ Industrial Hemp

To regulate industrial hemp as a traditional agricultural commodity



1. Cultivation flexibility (Section 1(2)(b); Section 5)
 - * Allows farmers to cultivate industrial hemp in fields and agricultural buildings
 - * Allows farmers to propagate using seeds, clones, cuttings, & transplants
 - * Promotes coexistence between hemp and other crops
2. Establishes a testing pathway for industrial hemp products intended for human consumption (Section 9):
 - * Authorizes testing by laboratories accredited by OHA and licensed by OLCC
 - * Testing regimen in-line with OHA and OLCC requirements for other cannabis items
3. Registration (Section 1 (1)(a), (2)(a); Section 2; Section 7; Section 9(3); Section 10(1)):
 - * Treats industrial hemp as a traditional agricultural crop and commodity
 - * Compliant with the Federal Farm Act of 2014, Section 7606 (b)(1)(B)(ii) .
