## Vote YES on House Bill 4003

House Bill 4003 extends the Law Enforcement Profiling Work Group to July 2017, and requires the Work Group to a report back to the Legislature by December 2016. The Law Enforcement Profiling Work Group, chaired by Attorney General Rosenblum, has made important strides in creating recommendations for the legislature on how to identify and stop patterns and practices of profiling by law enforcement.

We believe that by creating a comprehensive system which provides the tools to address police profiling—including data collection, independent oversight and accountability--all Oregonians will benefit from safer communities, more cooperation and trust, and equal justice for everyone. HB 4003 will give the Law Enforcement Profiling Work Group the critical space they need to accomplish those goals.
