- "(B) For calendar years after 2003, a rate adjusted for inflation as calculated by the commissioner under paragraph (b) of this subsection.
- "(b) No later than September 30 of each year, beginning in calendar year
- 14 2003, the commissioner shall calculate an adjustment of the wage amount
- specified in paragraph (a) of this subsection based upon the increase, if any,
- 16 from August of the preceding year to August of the year in which the cal-
- 17 culation is made in the U.S. City Average Consumer Price Index for All
- 18 Urban Consumers for All Items as prepared by the Bureau of Labor Statistics
- 19 of the United States Department of Labor or its successor.
- 20 "(c) The wage amount as adjusted under this subsection shall:
- 21 "(A) Be rounded to the nearest five cents; and

- "(B) Become effective as the new minimum wage amount applicable to members of the Legislative Assembly, replacing the dollar figure specified in
- 3 paragraph (a) of this subsection, on January 1 of the following year.".
