

- 17 from the Higher Education Coordination Commission, for the acquisi-
- 18 tion of and improvements to land and the acquisition, planning, con-
- 19 structing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of the
- 20 American Manufacturing Innovation District building at Portland
- 21 Community College.
- "SECTION 8. The moneys authorized for expenditure under section
- 23 1 (10), chapter 808, Oregon Laws 2015, may be used only for the fol-
- 24 lowing projects:
- 25 "(1) Projects to improve accessibility of the Capitol building to
- 26 persons with disabilities.
- "(2) Projects necessary to relocate offices of Oregon State Police to
- 28 the first floor of the Capitol building.
- "SECTION 9. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate
- 30 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is

declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
