WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Board of Dentistry (OBD), upon request of individual who has been disciplined by board, to remove from its website and other publicly accessible print and electronic publications information related to disciplining individual if individual meets certain criteria.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- The need for the distinction between minor and major violations
- Disciplinary actions that are technical in nature
- Violations that have not caused harm to patients
- Long term impacts to professionals
- The need for all professional boards to have the same policy

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:
