Measure Description:

Provides that employees of Oregon State Hospital qualify as police officers under Public Employees Retirement System.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Public Employees Retirement System (PERS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill provides that employees of the Oregon State Hospital qualify as "police officers" for the purpose of Public Employee Retirement System (PERS) benefits. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
