Measure Description:

Establishes criteria by which school district may establish post-graduate scholar program to receive and expend certain State School Fund moneys for certain students who have satisfied requirements for high school diploma.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, School Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes criteria by which a school district may establish a post-graduate scholar program to receive and expend certain State School Fund (SSF) moneys for students who have satisfied requirements for a high school diploma. ODE anticipates having a fiscal impact associated research and reporting, developing new administrative rules, and providing technical assistance to school districts. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
