**Measure Description:**

Lowers threshold for required filing of statement of independent expenditures to \$50 per calendar year and requires statement to be filed within five days of reaching threshold.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Secretary of State

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill lowers the threshold for when a statement of independent expenditures must be filed with the Secretary of State and makes other changes to the statutes regarding statements of independent expenditures. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of the impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
