Measure Description:

Requires state agency public records policies, and public record retention schedules of state agencies and political subdivisions of this state, to require retention of public records for a minimum of two years.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Judicial Department, Legislative Administration Committee (LAC), Secretary of State, Statewide

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill makes changes to the statutes regarding public records. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of the impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
