Measure Description:

Authorizes prosecution of first-degree sex crimes any time after commission of crime if prosecuting attorney obtains corroborating evidence of crime.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

District Attorneys and their Deputies, Department of Corrections, Department of Justice, Public Defense Services Commission, Judicial Department

Analysis:
