BACKGROUND:

Travis Moothart was born in Corvallis, Oregon, on February 3, 1980. He grew up in Brownsville, graduated from Central Linn High School in 1998, and went on to study mechanics at Linn-Benton Community College. He enlisted in the Army in 2000 and put his knowledged of mechanics to use while serving in South Korea and then in Iraq. He was killed by a roadside bomb on January 27, 2004. He was passionate about the things he valued the most: his son, his parents and siblings, and his friends. The Brownsville American Legion Post has been named for Sergeant Moothart, and he is remembered and recognized every year when his family awards the Travis A. Moothart Memorial Scholarship at the Central Linn High School graduation. House Concurrent Resolution honors him.
