## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes deadlines for presession-filing of legislative measures for 2017 regular session of Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly.

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon legislature has established a precedent for setting specific deadlines in advance of regular sessions and interims, to encourage timely execution of matters before the Legislative Assembly, by adopting a concurrent resolution to that effect. Prior to the conclusion of the 2014 legislative session, Senate Concurrent Resolution 206 was adopted to establish deadlines for presession-filing measures for the 2015 session.

House Concurrent Resolution 209 establishes presession deadlines for filing of legislative measures, in anticipation of the 2017 legislative Session.
