

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4042

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “and”.

2 In line 3, after “411.795” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 22 through 27 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services shall convene an advisory group that**
5 **includes individuals representing nonprofit agencies that, as part of their primary mission,**
6 **advocate for and provide services to low income adults. The department shall work with the**
7 **advisory group to:**

8 **“(1) Compile a list of attorneys to represent the participants in the general assistance**
9 **project described in section 1 of this 2016 Act in appealing adverse determinations by the**
10 **United States Social Security Administration; and**

11 **“(2) Develop metrics to evaluate the success of the project in securing for the individuals**
12 **participating in the project housing and Supplemental Security Income benefits or Social**
13 **Security Disability Insurance benefits.”.**

14 In line 28, delete “2” and insert “3”.

15 On page 2, line 12, delete “3” and insert “4”.

16 In line 34, delete “4” and insert “5”.

17 On page 3, line 9, delete “5” and insert “6”.

18 In line 13, delete “6” and insert “7”.

19 Delete lines 31 through 33 and insert:

20 **“SECTION 8. The Department of Human Services shall appoint the advisory group de-**
21 **scribed in section 2 of this 2016 Act no later than July 1, 2016.**

22 **“SECTION 9. Section 1 of this 2016 Act and the amendments to ORS 411.010, 411.081,**
23 **411.141, 411.760 and 411.795 by sections 3 to 7 of this 2016 Act become operative on July 1,**
24 **2016.**

25 **“SECTION 10. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appro-**
26 **riation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (1), chapter 760, Oregon**
27 **Laws 2015, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for central services, statewide assess-**
28 **ments and enterprise-wide costs, and program design services, is increased by \$81,717 for**
29 **administering the general assistance project described in section 1 of this 2016 Act.**

30 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
31 **to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (3), chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, for**
32 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for aging and people with disabilities and**
33 **intellectual/developmental disabilities programs, is increased by \$1,542,919 for administering**
34 **the general assistance project described in section 1 of this 2016 Act.**

35 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**

1 established by section 2 (4), chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium beginning July
2 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
3 including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indi-
4 rect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries and the Child
5 Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in
6 section 2, chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or received by the Department of Human
7 Services, for shared services, is increased by \$65,348 for administering the general assistance
8 project described in section 1 of this 2016 Act.

9 SECTION 11. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect
11 on its passage.”
