

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4057

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education, in collaboration with the Chief Education**
3 **Office, shall prepare a report related to students who are in poverty families.**

4 **“(2) The report required under this section shall include:**

5 **“(a) The total amounts allocated to each school district that receives an additional weight**
6 **from the State School Fund under ORS 327.013 (1)(c)(A)(v)(I) for students who are in poverty**
7 **families.**

8 **“(b) Information provided by school districts under subsection (3) of this section that**
9 **describes any promising practices, programs or services used or provided by the school dis-**
10 **trict to improve student achievement for students who are in poverty families.**

11 **“(c) A recommendation from the department and the office about whether additional re-**
12 **ports should be required and the information that should be collected for those reports.**

13 **“(3) For the purpose of collecting the information described in subsection (2)(b) of this**
14 **section, the department shall prescribe a form to be returned to the department by every**
15 **school district that receives an additional weight from the State School Fund under ORS**
16 **327.013 (1)(c)(A)(v)(I) for students who are in poverty families. The form shall include:**

17 **“(a) A list of any promising practices, programs or services used or provided by the**
18 **school district to improve student achievement for students who are in poverty families; and**

19 **“(b) The opportunity for a school district to provide:**

20 **“(A) A description of any promising practices, programs or services not listed in para-**
21 **graph (a) of this subsection;**

22 **“(B) The approximate cost of providing the promising practices, programs or services**
23 **listed in paragraph (a) of this subsection or described in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph;**
24 **and**

25 **“(C) A description of any promising practices, programs or services that a school district**
26 **would use or provide to improve student achievement for students in poverty families if the**
27 **school district had additional funding, and the approximate amount of additional funding that**
28 **the school district would need.**

29 **“(4) No later than February 15, 2017, the department shall:**

30 **“(a) Submit the report required under this section to the interim legislative committees**
31 **related to education.**

32 **“(b) Make available on the website of the department the report required under this**
33 **section.**

34 **“(c) Make available on the website of the department:**

35 **“(A) Information about any promising practices, programs and services for students from**

1 poverty families that a school or school district may implement to serve those students; and
2 “(B) When possible, contact information for the schools or school districts that have
3 implemented promising practices, programs or services for students from poverty families
4 that another school or school district may want to implement.

5 “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2016 Act is repealed on June 30, 2017.

6 “SECTION 3. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect
8 on its passage.”

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
