

House Bill 4057

Sponsored by Representatives WHISNANT, GALLEGOS, SPRENGER (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to prepare report related to educational performance of students from families in poverty.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to moneys allocated from the State School Fund for students from families in poverty; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education, in collaboration with the Chief Education**
6 **Office, shall prepare a report that is based on the information provided by school districts**
7 **under subsection (2) of this section related to the educational performance of students from**
8 **families in poverty.**

9 **(2) Each school district that has at least 60 students in average daily membership for**
10 **whom the school district receives an additional weight under ORS 327.013 (1)(c)(A)(v)(I) shall**
11 **provide the department with the following information:**

12 **(a) The total amounts allocated to the school district from the State School Fund for**
13 **students for whom an additional weight is received under ORS 327.013 (1)(c)(A)(v)(I).**

14 **(b) The total amounts expended from the amounts identified in paragraph (a) of this**
15 **subsection that are used for programs and services for students from families in poverty,**
16 **including any expansions of programs that are funded by federal moneys to assist students**
17 **from low-income families.**

18 **(c) An explanation of how the programs and services funded under paragraph (b) of this**
19 **subsection are designed to improve the educational outcomes for students from families in**
20 **poverty.**

21 **(d) A description of the methods by which the school district distributes the amounts**
22 **identified in paragraph (a) of this subsection to schools, including any methods that take into**
23 **account the poverty levels and the educational performances of the students in the schools.**

24 **(e) Any other information the department and office determine is necessary to demon-**
25 **strate how a school district is analyzing the performance of students from families in pov-**
26 **erty and implementing best practices to increase the educational performance of students**
27 **from families in poverty.**

28 **(3) No later than October 15, 2016, the department shall:**

29 **(a) Submit the report required under this section to the interim legislative committees**
30 **related to education. The report must include a recommendation from the department and**
31 **office about whether additional reports are required and the information that should be col-**

1 lected for those reports to evaluate the educational performance of students from families
2 in poverty.

3 (b) Make available the report required under this section on the website of the depart-
4 ment.

5 SECTION 2. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
6 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect
7 on its passage.

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
