Prohibits Oregon Health Authority from providing medical assistance coverage of specified treatments for gender dysphoria.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to medical assistance.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.

5 SECTION 2. The Oregon Health Authority may not pay the cost of the following services

6 provided to medical assistance recipients who are younger than 18 years of age:

7 (1) Sex reassignment surgery;

8 (2) Cross-sex hormone therapy; and

9 (3) Puberty suppression therapy.

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
