

House Bill 4092

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Effectiveness for University of Oregon)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires President of Senate and Speaker of House of Representatives to convene legislative work group to determine methods to improve process for preparing arguments in support of measures referred to electors by Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to measures referred by the Legislative Assembly; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall convene a legislative work group to determine methods to improve the process set forth in ORS 251.245 for preparing arguments in support of measures referred to the electors by the Legislative Assembly.

SECTION 2. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.
