SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Requires Department of State Lands to designate individual to act as liaison with Office of Emergency Management.]

Authorizes Office of Emergency Management to enter into agreement with Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon to form 9-1-1 jurisdiction.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to emergency management; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Office of Emergency Management may enter into an agreement with**
5 **the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon for the purpose of**
6 **forming an entity to participate in the emergency communications system.**

7 **(2) An entity formed under subsection (1) of this section:**

8 **(a) Is a 9-1-1 jurisdiction for purposes of ORS 305.823 and 403.105 to 403.250.**

9 **(b) Shall comply with all state and federal law applicable to 9-1-1 jurisdictions.**

10 **(c) Shall operate within a 9-1-1 service area that includes the Warm Springs Indian Res-**
11 **ervation.**

12 **(d) May operate a primary public safety answering point to provide emergency commu-**
13 **nications services within its 9-1-1 service area.**

14 **(3) As used in this section, "emergency communications system," "primary public safety**
15 **answering point," "9-1-1 jurisdiction" and "9-1-1 service area" have the meanings given those**
16 **terms in ORS 403.105.**

17 **SECTION 2. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect**
19 **on its passage.**
