## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Requires Department of State Lands to designate individual to act as liaison with Office of Emergency Management.]

Authorizes Office of Emergency Management to enter into agreement with Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon to form 9-1-1 jurisdiction.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to emergency management; and declaring an emergency.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Office of Emergency Management may enter into an agreement with the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon for the purpose of forming an entity to participate in the emergency communications system.
      - (2) An entity formed under subsection (1) of this section:
      - (a) Is a 9-1-1 jurisdiction for purposes of ORS 305.823 and 403.105 to 403.250.
      - (b) Shall comply with all state and federal law applicable to 9-1-1 jurisdictions.
- 10 (c) Shall operate within a 9-1-1 service area that includes the Warm Springs Indian Res-11 ervation.
  - (d) May operate a primary public safety answering point to provide emergency communications services within its 9-1-1 service area.
  - (3) As used in this section, "emergency communications system," "primary public safety answering point," "9-1-1 jurisdiction" and "9-1-1 service area" have the meanings given those terms in ORS 403.105.
  - <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.
