

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4110

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “ORS” insert “305.035, 305.065.”

2 On page 3, after line 19, insert:

3 “**SECTION 4.** ORS 305.035 is amended to read:

4 “305.035. (1) The Department of Revenue shall be under the supervision of the Director of the
5 Department of Revenue who shall be appointed for a term of four years and shall hold office at the
6 pleasure of the Governor. The director shall be skilled and expert in matters of taxation **or finan-**
7 **cial administration** and shall devote the entire time of the director to the performance of the duties
8 imposed upon the department.

9 “(2) The appointment of the director is subject to confirmation by the Senate under ORS 171.562
10 and 171.565. In case the Governor’s choice of a director is not confirmed, the Governor shall make
11 another appointment subject to the confirmation by the Senate as provided in this subsection.

12 “(3) The director shall receive such salary as may be provided by law. In addition to salary, the
13 director, subject to the limitations otherwise provided by law, shall be reimbursed for all reasonable
14 expenses necessarily incurred by the director in the performance of official duties. Before entering
15 upon the duties of office, the director shall be bonded under ORS 291.011.

16 “**SECTION 5.** ORS 305.065 is amended to read:

17 “305.065. The Director of the Department of Revenue, with the approval of the Governor, may
18 designate a deputy director, to serve at the pleasure of the director, with full authority to act for
19 the director, but subject to the control of the director. The deputy director shall be skilled and ex-
20 pert in matters of taxation **or financial administration** and shall devote the entire time of the
21 deputy director to the performance of the duties of the deputy director in the department. The des-
22 ignation of a deputy director shall be by written order filed with the Secretary of State.

23 “**SECTION 6. Section 7 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 469B.270 to**
24 **469B.306.**

25 “**SECTION 7. Notwithstanding ORS 469B.285 (6), a preliminary certificate issued under**
26 **ORS 469B.288 shall remain valid until August 31, 2016, for a project:**

27 “(1) **That is to be constructed or installed in a county with an area in excess of 10,000**
28 **square miles; and**

29 “(2) **For which preliminary certification currently expires on June 28, 2016.”.**

30 In line 20, delete “4” and insert “8”.

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
