House Bill 4126

Sponsored by Representatives LIVELY, WHISNANT; Senator BEYER (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits cities outside Metro to complete evaluations and amendments of urban growth boundaries under statutes and administrative rules in effect on June 30, 2013. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to evaluation and amendment of urban growth boundaries outside Metro initiated prior to

3 January 1, 2016; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 197A.320, a city outside of Metro that submitted to the

6 Director of the Department of Land Conservation and Development, pursuant to ORS 197.610,

7 a proposed change to an acknowledged comprehensive plan or a land use regulation that in-

8 cluded an evaluation or an amendment of its urban growth boundary, or that received ap-

9 proval of a periodic review work program that included a work task to amend or evaluate its

10 urban growth boundary pursuant to ORS 197.633, prior to January 1, 2016, but did not com-

11 plete the evaluation or amendment of its urban growth boundary prior to January 1, 2016,

12 may complete the evaluation or amendment pursuant to statutes and administrative rules

13 **in effect on June 30, 2013.**

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 15 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect 16 upon passage.
