CHAPTER	

AN ACT

Relating to coordinated care organizations; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 413.

SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "capacity" means the maximum number of members that a coordinated care organization may serve as determined by the Oregon Health Authority in accordance with ORS 414.645 (1).

- (2) The authority may determine that there is a need to change a geographic area served by a coordinated care organization and solicit applications from other coordinated care organizations to expand into the geographic area already served by the coordinated care organization only if:
- (a) The coordinated care organization already serving the geographic area withdraws from all or a portion of the geographic area; and
- (b) Other coordinated care organizations operating in the same geographic area do not have adequate capacity to enroll the members affected by the coordinated care organization's withdrawal from all or part of the geographic area.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2016 Act is repealed on December 31, 2018.

SECTION 4. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.
