

# House Bill 4141

Sponsored by Representative HAYDEN (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to change size of geographic area served by coordinated care organization under specified conditions.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to coordinated care organizations; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 413.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "capacity" means the maximum number of**  
6 **members that a coordinated care organization may serve as determined by the Oregon**  
7 **Health Authority in accordance with ORS 414.645 (1).**

8 **(2) The authority may determine that there is a need to change a geographic area served**  
9 **by a coordinated care organization and solicit applications from other coordinated care or-**  
10 **ganizations to expand into the geographic area already served by the coordinated care or-**  
11 **ganization only if:**

12 **(a) The coordinated care organization already serving the geographic area withdraws**  
13 **from all or a portion of the geographic area; and**

14 **(b) Other coordinated care organizations operating in the same geographic area do not**  
15 **have adequate capacity to enroll the members affected by the coordinated care organization's**  
16 **withdrawal from all or part of the geographic area.**

17 **SECTION 3. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect**  
19 **on its passage.**
