House Bill 4141

Sponsored by Representative HAYDEN (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to change size of geographic area served by coordinated care organization under specified conditions.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to coordinated care organizations; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 413.
 - SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "capacity" means the maximum number of members that a coordinated care organization may serve as determined by the Oregon Health Authority in accordance with ORS 414.645 (1).
 - (2) The authority may determine that there is a need to change a geographic area served by a coordinated care organization and solicit applications from other coordinated care organizations to expand into the geographic area already served by the coordinated care organization only if:
 - (a) The coordinated care organization already serving the geographic area withdraws from all or a portion of the geographic area; and
 - (b) Other coordinated care organizations operating in the same geographic area do not have adequate capacity to enroll the members affected by the coordinated care organization's withdrawal from all or part of the geographic area.
 - <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.
