

# HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5201

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “section 7” and insert “sections 3, 4, 6, 7, 10, 13, 15 and  
2 18”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** Section 7, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

5 “**Sec. 7.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall establish a process for al-  
6 locating available moneys in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund on a quar-  
7 terly basis to fulfill the biennial allocations made by sections 1 to 13 [*of this 2015 Act*], **chapter 811,**  
8 **Oregon Laws 2015, and by this 2016 Act.** The department shall set the quarterly allocations.

9 “(2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Administrative  
10 Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations made by  
11 sections 1 to 13 [*of this 2015 Act or any other 2015 Act*], **chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, or by**  
12 **this 2016 Act,** prior to making any other allocations pursuant to sections 1 to 13 [*of this 2015*  
13 *Act*], **chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, or pursuant to this 2016 Act,** the department shall satisfy  
14 lottery bond debt service obligations in the amount of \$225,477,038 for outstanding lottery bonds.

15 “(3) After the lottery bond debt service obligations described in subsection (2) of this section  
16 are satisfied, if the remaining moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Administrative  
17 Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations made by  
18 sections 1 to 13 [*of this 2015 Act*], **chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, or by this 2016 Act,** the de-  
19 partment shall reduce the quarterly allocations not described in subsection (2) of this section pro-  
20 portionately in amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

21 “**SECTION 2.** **There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Ad-**  
22 **ministrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business Development**  
23 **Department, the amount of \$400,000 for support of redevelopment of the Port of Port Orford**  
24 **Cannery Building.**

25 “**SECTION 3.** Section 3, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

26 “**Sec. 3.** The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the  
27 Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business Development Depart-  
28 ment, for the following purposes:

- 29 (1) Shared services..... [\$ 7,037,404]
- 30 ..... \$ **7,223,270**
- 31 (2) Business, innovation
- 32 and trade..... [\$50,866,257]
- 33 ..... \$ **51,400,966**
- 34 (3) Infrastructure
- 35 Finance Authority..... [\$ 3,025,181]

1 ..... \$ **3,405,177**

2 (4) Oregon Film and Video Office..... \$ 1,164,460

3 **“SECTION 4.** Section 4, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

4 **“Sec. 4.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Administrative  
5 Services Economic Development Fund, to the Department of Education, for the State School Fund,  
6 the amount of [~~\$408,150,516~~] **\$447,703,907.**

7 **“SECTION 5.** Section 6, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

8 **“Sec. 6.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Administrative  
9 Services Economic Development Fund, to the office of the Governor, the amount of [~~\$4,058,418~~]  
10 **\$4,209,051** for expenses of the Regional Solutions Program.

11 **“SECTION 6.** Section 10, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

12 **“Sec. 10.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.549 (2) for a percentage-  
13 based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, the amount allocated from the  
14 Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund is  
15 [~~\$11,292,544~~] **\$11,348,753.**

16 **“SECTION 7.** Section 13, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

17 **“Sec. 13.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Administrative  
18 Services Economic Development Fund, to the State Forestry Department, the amount of  
19 [~~\$5,000,000~~] **\$5,072,136** for federal forest restoration.

20 **“SECTION 8.** Section 15, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

21 **“Sec. 15.** There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for the  
22 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Criminal Fine Account, the following amounts for the  
23 following purposes:

24 (1) Criminal justice training  
25 and standards operations..... [~~\$27,250,583~~]  
26 ..... **\$ 31,080,778**

27 (2) Public Safety Memorial Fund ..... \$ 128,420

28 **“SECTION 9.** Section 18, chapter 811, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

29 **“Sec. 18.** There are allocated to the State Court Facilities and Security Account established  
30 under ORS 1.178, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Criminal Fine Account, the fol-  
31 lowing amounts for the following purposes:

32 (1) State court security  
33 and emergency preparedness..... [~~\$ 3,422,322~~]  
34 ..... **\$ 3,446,002**

35 (2) Distributions to county court  
36 facilities security accounts..... \$ 4,148,922

37 (3) Capital improvements for  
38 courthouses and other state  
39 court facilities..... \$ 3,500,000

40 **“SECTION 10. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
41 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect**  
42 **on its passage.”.**
