

House Bill 5202

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Revises amounts authorized for issuance of general obligation bonds of state during 2015-2017 biennium.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; amending section 1, chapter 685, Oregon Laws 2015; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 1, chapter 685, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

Sec. 1. The amounts authorized, as provided by ORS 286A.035, for issuance of general obligation bonds of the state during the 2015-2017 biennium are as follows:
