

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 202

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 Delete lines 5 through 23 of the printed joint resolution and insert:

2 **“SECTION 4f. (1) Effective July 1, 2017, two percent of the net proceeds from the State**
3 **Lottery shall be deposited, from the fund created by the Legislative Assembly under para-**
4 **graph (d) of subsection (4) of section 4 of this Article, in a veterans’ services fund created**
5 **by the Legislative Assembly. The Legislative Assembly may not limit expenditures from the**
6 **veterans’ services fund. The Legislative Assembly may appropriate other moneys or revenue**
7 **to the veterans’ services fund.**

8 **“(2) In each biennium the Legislative Assembly shall appropriate all of the moneys in the**
9 **veterans’ services fund to provide services for the benefit of veterans. Such services may**
10 **include, without limitation:**

11 **“(a) Assistance for veterans with reintegration, employment, education benefits and tui-**
12 **tion, housing, physical and mental health care and addiction treatment programs;**

13 **“(b) Assistance for veterans, spouses of veterans or dependents of veterans in accessing**
14 **state and federal benefits; and**

15 **“(c) Funding services provided by county veterans’ service officers, campus veterans’**
16 **service officers or nonprofit or tribal veterans’ service officers.**

17 **“(3) As used in this section, ‘veteran’ means a resident of the State of Oregon who served**
18 **in the Armed Forces of the United States.”.**
