

Senate Bill 1501

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Rules and Executive Appointments)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Corrects statutory reference from section 9, chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015, to ensure ability of minor political parties to maintain status for 2016 general election based on number of registered electors as of July 1, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to calculation for maintaining status as a minor political party; amending section 9, chapter
3 8, Oregon Laws 2015; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 9, chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 9.** For the purpose of maintaining status as a minor political party under ORS 248.008
7 [(4)(b)] (4)(a) for the general election to be held on November 8, 2016, the total number of registered
8 electors in this state is deemed to be the total number of registered electors identified in the elector
9 registration records of the Secretary of State on July 1, 2015.

10 **SECTION 2.** **This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
