

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1515

1 On page 41 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 22, insert:

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3 **“APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURE LIMITATIONS**

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5 **“SECTION 62.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
6 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (1), chapter 760, Oregon Laws
7 2015, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for central services, statewide assessments and
8 enterprise-wide costs, and program design services, is increased by \$229,031 for the purposes
9 of implementing and administering the provisions of this 2016 Act.

10 **“SECTION 63.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
11 expenditures established by section 3 (1), chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium
12 beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
13 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or
14 received by the Department of Human Services, for central services, statewide assessments
15 and enterprise-wide costs, and program design services, is increased by \$113,564 for the
16 purposes of implementing and administering the provisions of this 2016 Act.

17 **“SECTION 64.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
18 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (2), chapter 760, Oregon Laws
19 2015, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for child welfare, self-sufficiency and vocational
20 rehabilitation services, is increased by \$140,000 for the purposes of implementing and ad-
21 ministering the provisions of this 2016 Act.

22 **“SECTION 65.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
23 expenditures established by section 3 (2), chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium
24 beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
25 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or
26 received by the Department of Human Services, for child welfare, self-sufficiency and voca-
27 tional rehabilitation services, is increased by \$140,000 for the purposes of implementing and
28 administering the provisions of this 2016 Act.

29 **“SECTION 66.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
30 expenditures established by section 2 (4), chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium
31 beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
32 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal
33 funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries
34 and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not
35 described in section 2, chapter 760, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or received by the Depart-

1 **ment of Human Services, for shared services, is increased by \$96,659 for the purposes of**
2 **implementing and administering the provisions of this 2016 Act.**

3 **“SECTION 67. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
4 **expenditures established by section 2 (3), chapter 692, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium**
5 **beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**
6 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal**
7 **funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice for the Civil Enforcement Division,**
8 **is increased by \$176,018, for the Child Advocacy Section, for the purposes of implementing**
9 **and administering the provisions of this 2016 Act.”.**
