

Senate Bill 1541

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation related to financial accountability of school districts.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to school financial accountability; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall conduct an evaluation of methods for**
5 **tracking:**

6 **(a) Amounts allocated to school districts for specified purposes or distributed to school**
7 **districts in addition to previous distributions; and**

8 **(b) How amounts identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection are expended by the**
9 **school districts.**

10 **(2) The department shall submit a report on the evaluation described in subsection (1)**
11 **of this section to the interim legislative committees on education no later than October 15,**
12 **2016.**

13 **SECTION 2. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
