SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies day on which odd-numbered year regular session of Legislative Assembly commences to be day after adjournment of organizational session or, if day after adjournment is Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday, on following Monday.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to sessions of the Legislative Assembly; amending ORS 171.010.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 171.010 is amended to read:

171.010. **(1) The odd-numbered year regular session** [*The regular sessions*] of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at the capital of the state and shall commence on the first day [*of February of each year,*] **after adjournment of the organizational session described in Article IV, section 10 (2), of the Oregon Constitution,** except that if the first day [*of February*] **after adjournment of the organizational session** is a Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday, the regular session shall commence on the following Monday.

(2) The even-numbered year regular session of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at the capital of the state and shall commence on the first day of February, except that if the first day of February is a Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday, the regular session shall commence on the following Monday.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
