## Senate Bill 1570

Sponsored by Senator COURTNEY (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Legislative Assembly to convene in organizational session in advance of odd-numbered year and even-numbered year regular sessions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to organizational sessions of the Legislative Assembly; amending ORS 171.010.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
SECTION 1. ORS 171.010 is amended to read:
171.010. (1) As used in this section, "organizational session" means a session described in
Article IV, section 10 (2), of the Oregon Constitution.
(2) The organizational sessions preceding the odd-numbered year regular sessions of the
Legislative Assembly shall be held at the capital of the state and shall commence on the
second Monday in January of each odd-numbered year.
(3) The organizational sessions preceding the even-numbered year regular sessions of the
Legislative Assembly shall be held at the capital of the state and shall commence on a date
in January of the even-numbered year that is established by resolution of the Legislative
Assembly.
(4) The regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at the capital of the state and

and 14 15shall commence on the first day of February of each year, except that if the first day of February is a Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday, the regular session shall commence on the following 16 Monday. 17
