## Senate Bill 1595

Sponsored by Senator COURTNEY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits administration of affirmation to witnesses in legislative proceedings. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

 A BILL FOR AN ACT

 Relating to witnesses in legislative proceedings; amending ORS 171.505; and declaring an emergency.

 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 171.505 is amended to read:

5 171.505. The President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the chair-6 person or vice chairperson of any statutory, standing, special or interim committee of either house

7 of the Legislative Assembly, or the chairperson or vice chairperson of a statutory, standing, special

8 or interim joint committee of the two houses, may administer oaths or affirmations to witnesses

9 in any proceedings under their examination.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect
 on its passage.
