

Senate Bill 5701

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases and decreases certain biennial appropriations made from General Fund to specified state agencies.

Increases limitations on expenditures for certain biennial expenses for specified state agencies.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by specified state agencies.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
5 **expenditures established by section 4 (1), chapter 694, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium**
6 **beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds**
7 **collected or received by the Oregon Business Development Department for business, inno-**
8 **vation and trade, is increased by \$61,227.**

9 **(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**
10 **established by section 2 (1), chapter 694, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium beginning July**
11 **1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,**
12 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or**
13 **received by the Oregon Business Development Department for business, innovation and**
14 **trade, is increased by \$388,773.**

15 **(3)(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
16 **to the Oregon Business Development Department by section 1 (2), chapter 694, Oregon Laws**
17 **2015, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for debt service, is decreased by \$1,328,407.**

18 **(b) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,330,500 is es-**
19 **tablished for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-**
20 **penditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding**
21 **lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Business Development**
22 **Department, for general obligation bond debt service.**

23 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
24 **expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter 759, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium**
25 **beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,**
26 **other than those described in sections 6 and 9, chapter 759, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or**
27 **received by the Department of Education, for operations, is increased by \$7,130,223 for a**
28 **charter schools grant.**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 **SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
2 made to the Department of Education by section 2 (4), chapter 759, Oregon Laws 2015, for
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, to be distributed as grants-in-aid, for program costs and
4 to purchase services for breakfast and summer food programs, is decreased by \$51,458.

5 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
6 made to the Department of Education by section 1 (1), chapter 759, Oregon Laws 2015, for
7 the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for operations, is increased \$51,458.

8 **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
9 expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter 759, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium
10 beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
11 other than those described in sections 6 and 9 of chapter 759, Oregon Laws 2015, collected
12 or received by the Department of Education, for operations, is increased by \$1,160,860 for
13 child nutrition grants.

14 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
15 expenditures established by section 7 (3), chapter 759, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium
16 beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs,
17 and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-
18 cepts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department
19 of Education for programs other than those specified in sections 4 and 9, chapter 759, Oregon
20 Laws 2015, is increased by \$515,200 for all other grants for the increase in the number of
21 number of students participating in the Hospital Program.

22 **SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
23 expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 658, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium
24 beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
25 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal
26 funds, collected or received by the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, for
27 operations, is increased by \$959,000 for developing and disseminating research-based com-
28 munity policing skills through the Oregon Center for Policing Excellence.

29 **SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
30 made to the State Forestry Department by section 1 (1), chapter 809, Oregon Laws 2015, for
31 the biennium beginning on July 1, 2015, is increased by \$23,115,122 for the payment of emer-
32 gency firefighting costs associated with the 2015 forest fire season.

33 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
34 expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter 809, Oregon Laws 2015, for the biennium
35 beginning July 1, 2015, is increased by \$56,334,408 for the payment of emergency firefighting
36 costs associated with the 2015 forest fire season.

37 **SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
38 made to the Emergency Board by section 5 (1), chapter 809, Oregon Laws 2015, for the
39 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is decreased by \$2,054,823.

40 **SECTION 11.** This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
41 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect
42 on its passage.
