  - "(b) No later than September 30 of each year, beginning in [calendar year 2003] 2023, the commissioner shall calculate an adjustment of the wage amount specified in subsection (1)(j) of this section based upon the increase, if any, [(if any)] from August of the preceding year to August of the year in which the calculation is made in the U.S. City Average Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All Items as prepared by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor or its successor.
    - "(c) The wage amount [established] as adjusted under this subsection shall[:]
- "[(A)] be rounded to the nearest five cents[; and].
  - "[(B)] (d) The wage amount as adjusted under this subsection [become] becomes effective as the new Oregon minimum wage amount, replacing the [dollar figure specified in subsection (1)] minimum wage amount specified in subsection (1)(j) of this section, on January 1 of the following year.
