PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4093

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 13 through 18 and insert:

"(3) The county may not impose a surcharge under this section unless,
before October 1 of the calendar year preceding the imposition of the surcharge, the county notifies the Judicial Department of its intention to impose
the surcharge.

6 "(4) The surcharge shall be collected by the circuit court for the county 7 and must be:

8 "(a) Transferred to the Oregon Courthouse Capital Construction and Im-9 provement Fund and used solely to finance capital costs related to replacing 10 or remodeling the courthouse in the county imposing the surcharge;

"(b) Transferred to the Article XI-Q Bond Fund established in ORS 286A.820 for payment of the debt service on any portion of Article XI-Q bonds issued for replacing or remodeling the courthouse in the county imposing the surcharge; or

"(c) Used for payment of capital costs or debt service for replacing or
 remodeling the courthouse in the county imposing the surcharge.".

17 On page 2, delete lines 11 through 15 and insert:

"(a) The county has legislative authorization to receive funds for a county
courthouse from the proceeds of Article XI-Q bonds deposited in the Oregon
Courthouse Capital Construction and Improvement Fund established in section 64, chapter 723, Oregon Laws 2013, and debt service is still owed on the

1 Article XI-Q bonds related to the courthouse in the county;

"(b) Debt service is owed on any bonds issued under ORS 271.390 or ORS
chapter 287A to finance capital costs of replacing or remodeling the courthouse; and".

5 Delete lines 23 through 26 and insert:

6 "(5) The surcharge shall be used solely for payment of capital costs of 7 replacing or remodeling the courthouse in the county imposing the surcharge 8 or for payment of debt service and related expenses for bonds issued under 9 ORS 271.390 or ORS chapter 287A to finance capital costs of replacing or 10 remodeling the courthouse.".
