**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1515**

1 On page 39 of the printed bill, after line 42, insert:

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3 **“QUARTERLY LEGISLATIVE REPORTS REGARDING**
4 **CHILD-CARING AGENCIES**

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6 **“SECTION 58. (1) The Department of Human Services shall submit**
7 **a quarterly report to the committees or interim committees of the**
8 **Legislative Assembly on child welfare. The report shall include:**

9 **“(a) The number of child-caring agencies, as defined in ORS 418.205,**
10 **in this state.**

11 **“(b) The number of children served by child-caring agencies.**

12 **“(c) The number of child-caring agencies that are not in full com-**
13 **pliance with the requirements of ORS 418.240 at the time of the report.**

14 **“(d) The number of child-caring agencies operating at the time of**
15 **the report that are subject to a letter of intent or order to revoke the**
16 **agency’s license, certificate or other authorization to operate. The**
17 **department shall provide, concurrent with each quarterly report,**
18 **copies of any letters or orders in effect at the time of the report.**

19 **“(e) The number of child-caring agencies that have rescinded a**
20 **contract or have otherwise failed or been unable to comply with the**
21 **agency’s obligations under a contract with the department, and the**

1 reasons specified for the rescission, failure or inability to comply.

2 “(f) The number of civil penalties imposed on child-caring agencies,
3 including information about the amount of, and nature of the defi-
4 ciencies giving rise to, the penalties.

5 “(g) The number of reports or allegations of abuse received by, or
6 known to, the department involving children receiving care or services
7 at child-caring agencies, and:

8 “(A) The number of cases of abuse closed at screening;

9 “(B) The number of cases of abuse investigated by the department;

10 “(C) The number of substantiated allegations or reports of abuse;

11 “(D) The number of unsubstantiated allegations or reports of abuse;

12 “(E) The number of inconclusive allegations or reports of abuse;

13 “(F) The number of investigations in progress at the time the report
14 is made;

15 “(G) The average number of days to complete an investigation of
16 abuse;

17 “(H) The shortest number of days it took the department to com-
18 plete an investigation of abuse; and

19 “(I) The longest number of days it took the department to complete
20 an investigation of abuse.

21 “(2) The report may not contain the name of any child-caring
22 agency for which information is provided, except that the name of a
23 child-caring agency that is subject to a letter of intent or order to re-
24 voke need not be redacted from the copy of the letter or order that is
25 submitted with the report to the committees.

26 “SECTION 59. Section 58 of this 2016 Act is repealed on June 30,
27 2020.”.

28 In line 43, delete “58” and insert “60”.

29 On page 40, line 1, delete “59” and insert “61”.

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
