- 9 "(c) 'Reclamation' has the meaning given that term in ORS 517.750.
- "(d) 'Surface mining' has the meaning given that term in ORS 11 517.750.
- "(e) 'Wetlands' has the meaning given that term in ORS 196.800.
- "(2) Wetlands may be created, restored or enhanced under ORS
  14 215.213 (1)(o) or 215.283 (1)(m):
- 15 "(a) In an area lying east of the summit of the Coast Range;
- "(b) In an area lying west of the summit of the Coast Range that
  is located in a county where the total area of wetlands and aquatic
  habitat on land zoned for exclusive farm use in the county, as reported
  in an inventory maintained by the National Resources Conservation
  Service of the United States Department of Agriculture, or its successor agency, has not increased by more than \_\_\_\_\_ percent since 1992;
  or
  - "(c) In an area lying west of the summit of the Coast Range that is located in a county where the total area of wetlands and aquatic habitat on land zoned for exclusive farm use in the county, as reported in an inventory maintained by the National Resources Conservation Service of the United States Department of Agriculture, or its successor agency, has increased by more than \_\_\_\_ percent since 1992, if:
- 29 "(A) The owners or authorized land managers of parcels imme-30 diately adjacent to, or that may be reasonably anticipated to be af-

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- fected by, the creation, restoration or enhancement of wetlands have consented, in writing, to the activity; or
- "(B) The creation, restoration or enhancement of wetlands will not materially damage or reduce the effectiveness of existing agricultural drainage infrastructure or farm roads associated with parcels immediately adjacent to, or that may be reasonably anticipated to be affected by, the wetlands, or result in an increase in costs to the owners of immediately adjacent parcels of more than \$500 per year.
- "(3) Subsection (2)(c) of this section does not authorize the creation, restoration or enhancement of wetlands under ORS 215.213 (1)(o) or 215.283 (1)(m):
- 12 "(a) For purposes related to a mitigation bank.
  - "(b) For reclamation of lands affected by surface mining.
  - "(c) That are converted wetlands or farmed wetlands, so long as commercial agricultural production on the land has not been abandoned for five or more years.".
- Delete lines 25 through 45 and insert:

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- **"SECTION 7.** ORS 496.270 is amended to read:
- 19 "496.270. (1) The Legislative Assembly declares that it is the policy of the 20 State of Oregon to encourage operators, timber owners and landowners to 21 voluntarily improve fish and wildlife habitat. In order to carry out this pol-22 icy, the Legislative Assembly encourages cooperation among operators, tim-23 ber owners and landowners and other volunteers.
- "(2) Consistent with the limitations of ORS 105.672 to 105.696, a landowner is not liable in contract or tort for any personal injury, death or property damage that arises out of the use of the land by:
- 27 "(a) A volunteer conducting a fish and wildlife habitat improvement 28 project; or
- 29 "(b) A participant of a state-funded or federally funded watershed or 30 stream restoration or enhancement program.

- "(3) An operator, timber owner or landowner [shall not] **may not** be held liable for any damages resulting from:
- 3 "(a) A fish and wildlife habitat improvement project done in cooperation
- 4 and consultation with the State Department of Fish and Wildlife or the
- 5 Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, or conducted as part of a forest
- 6 management practice in accordance with ORS 527.610 to 527.770, 527.990 and
- 7 527.992; or
- 8 "(b) Leaving large woody debris within the waters of this state to protect,
- 9 retain and recruit large woody debris for the purposes of fish habitat and
- 10 water quality improvement.
- "(4)(a) The limitations to liability provided by subsections (2) and (3) of
- 12 this section do not apply if:
- 13 "(A) The damages, injury or death was caused by willful, wanton or in-
- 14 tentional conduct on the part of the operator, timber owner or landowner
- or by the gross negligence of the operator, timber owner or landowner.
- 16 "(B) For a project or portion of a project for the creation, restora-
- 17 tion or enhancement of wetlands, the operator, timber owner or
- 18 landowner has not provided sufficient notice of the project to owners
  - of the land that is immediately adjacent to the land on which the
- 20 **project occurs.**

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- 21 "(b) As used in this subsection:
- "(A) 'Gross negligence' means negligence which is materially greater
- 23 than the mere absence of reasonable care under the circumstances, and
- 24 which is characterized by indifference to or reckless disregard of the rights
- of others.
- 26 "(B) 'Sufficient notice' means written notice, through a regulatory
- 27 process or otherwise, that is provided at least 90 days before the start
- 28 of construction on a wetlands creation, restoration or enhancement
- 29 project.

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"(C) 'Wetlands' has the meaning given that term in ORS 196.800.
