PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4135

- On page 4 of the printed bill, after line 24, insert:
- "SECTION 5. Section 6 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 192.410 to 192.505.
- 4 "SECTION 6. (1) As used in this section:
- 5 "(a) 'Complex record request' means a request that is not a routine 6 record request.
- 7 "(b) 'Routine record request' means a request:
- 8 "(A) For public records that are stored in electronic format and 9 contain text that is electronically searchable;
 - "(B) That may be completely processed using electronic search tools that are available in the custodian's electronic storage system; and
 - "(C) That results in the production of records in an amount not to exceed one gigabyte of data.
- "(2)(a) The office of Public Records Ombudsman is established in the office of the Secretary of State to serve as a mediator between a requester of public records and a custodian of public records.
- "(b) The Minority Leader of the House of Representatives and the Minority Leader of the Senate shall jointly appoint an individual to serve as the Public Records Ombudsman.
- 20 "(3) A requester or a custodian of public records may submit a re-21 quest to the office of the Public Records Ombudsman requesting that

- the ombudsman review the record request and determine whether the request is a routine record request or a complex record request.
 - "(4) If the ombudsman determines that the request is a complex record request, the ombudsman shall assist the requester, to the extent practicable, in making the request a routine record request.
 - "(5) If the ombudsman determines that the request, in whole or in part, is a routine record request, the ombudsman shall notify the requester and the custodian of the determination. Within two weeks of receiving notice of the determination, the custodian shall fulfill any part of the request that is a routine record request. If the custodian does not, within the time allowed, fulfill the request, the custodian shall pay the sum of \$100 to the requester for each day the custodian does not fulfill the request."
